

2024-25 Dance Company Information Sheet Premiere Company

Time Commitment: Minimum of 6-7 hours for Mini Premiere (approx. Ages 7-8); 7-9 hours for Junior and Preteen Premiere (approx. ages 8-11). 10-12 hours of class time per week Teen and Senior Premiere groups (ages approx. 12-18). Additional time for choreography sessions, rehearsals, and master classes will be required throughout the year. *Dancers in Premiere must be willing to commit to some Saturdays for performances, rehearsals, competitions, and conventions*.

Description: A company for very committed dancers who are interested in a more intense schedule with increased performance opportunities, and **who are willing to make dance a top priority in their schedule** (excessive absences in Company will result in being spaced out of sections in their dances). Dancers in Premiere will attend and compete in dance competitions and convention classes.

Age/Prerequisites: Open to dancers grades 1st - HS. Dancers must have at least two years of dance company experience *or equivalent*.

Core Classes: Core hours for Mini premiere; ballet (2), jazz, jazz technique, contemporary, stretch & flexibility and hip-hop. Junior and Preteen Premiere Dancers: ballet (2), jazz, jazz technique, contemporary, hip hop, ballroom, stretch & flexibility and prepointe/pointe. Teen and Senior Premiere Dancers: Core hours of ballet (2), pointe, jazz, across the floor, contemporary, technique/leaps & turns, stretch & flexibility, combos, ballroom and hip hop.

Base Tuition: 6-7 hours at \$240-\$270. 7-9 Hours at \$270-\$310. 10-12 Hours at \$325-\$345 per month. (All companies have registration, recital, and costume fees. Base tuition is required for core hours only. Additional classes are charged per hour.)

Additional Costs:

- Choreography: approx. \$150-\$350 per dance (Number of Dances TBD)
- Three competitions, may travel to Cedar City/St. George for one of those competitions. \$400-\$525 for each regular competition (fees for travel is NA but should be considered into the cost of the competition). Costumes: approx. \$120-\$180 per costume (Number of Costumes TBD)
- Master Class fees (required) \$35 per class
- Company Motivational/Activities Fee (required) \$75
